Due to current risk assessments in school relating to Covid 19, we will be adapting plans for our usual summer events. Staffing Changes

Summer Uniform

As we are hoping for some good weather next half term, please check that your children are in light grey trousers, skirts or shorts with their white t-shirts and red jumpers or cardigans. Red and white check dresses are also part of our summer uniform with white socks and children need to have black school shoes and sandshoes for in the classroom. They also need to bring in their summer PE kit of a plain white t-shirt and red shorts with trainers.

Free School Meals

Since September 2014, all children who are in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 in a state-funded school are offered a free, healthy school lunch. Although they receive a free school meal, this does not automatically qualify them for pupil premium funding. Children will qualify for pupil premium funding, including a free school meal in other year groups, if their parent is in receipt of eligible benefits.



Are you entitled?

If you feel you may be eligible for free school meals, you can apply via the Hull City Council website and it only takes a couple of minutes: Free school meals | Hull City Council

The cost of a school meal for children in Years 3, 4, 5, and 6 who are not entitled to free school meals is £1.50 a day.

Please speak to a member of the Admin team if you need any support with making an application.

- Contact the Access and Assessment team for Hull on 01482 448879


Out of school hours and during school holidays:
