SCHOOL UNIFORM

We encourage you also write children's names in their uniform items in case these are misplaced.

PEKITS

Please ensure your child has their PE kit in school for their PE days. The PE kit consists of plain red shorts and plain white t-shirts. Outdoor kits of plain black joggers and plain black sweatshirts can also be worn when PE takes place outside, so children will also need their trainers on these days.

ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

A good attendance record has a positive impact on children's achievement, their ability to socialise and their emotional wellbeing. It is also essential that children arrive in school on time each day to ensure they do not miss out on their learning. Classroom doors are open from **8.45am and registration is at 8.55am.**

Breakfast club is available daily for working parents from 7.45am and costs £1 per child per day, this should be pre-booked via ParentMail or through the school office. Children can arrive at breakfast club up to 8.20am.

Please remember that we are unable to authorise any absences due to holidays taken during term time and that penalty notices may be issued (£60 per parent, per child). Please notify the school office if your child is absent for illness or a medical appointment.
