## ATTENDANCE

A good attendance record has a positive impact on children's achievement, their ability to socialise and their emotional wellbeing. Please remember that we are unable to authorise any absences due to holidays taken during term time and that penalty notices may be issued (£60 per parent, per child). Please notify the school office first thing in the morning if your child is absent for illness or a medical appointment.

## PUNCTUALITY

May I remind you that classroom doors are open from **8.45am** and **registration is at 8.55am. Children need to be in the classroom for this registration time.**
