Attendance

A good attendance record has a positive impact on children's achievement, their ability to socialise and their emotional wellbeing. Please remember that we are unable to authorise any absences due to holidays taken during term time and that penalty notices may be issued (£60 per parent, per child). Please notify the school office first thing in the morning if your child is absent for illness or a medical appointment.

Punctuality

It is also essential that children arrive in school on time each day to ensure they do not miss out on their learning. We have recently noticed an increase in children arriving late and having to come into school via the school office. Classroom doors are open from 8.45am and registration is at 8.55am. Children need to be in the classroom for this registration time.

Uniform

The children look smart in their red, white and grey, which is often commented on by visitors. Please remember to ensure your child wears their **plain** black school shoes everyday (trainers should also be plain black with no coloured stripes or soles) and that they need a pair of black sandshoes to change into to wear in school. Thank you for your support with our uniform policy.

Food Allergies

It is extremely generous and kind when children wish to share treats with their class mates to celebrate their birthdays. However, due to issues with allergies, we are unable to share homemade treats or cut up cakes. Please could we ask that any treats sent in for this purpose are pre-packed so that children can take these away with them for parents to check before eating? Thank you for your support with this.

Throughout this half term we have continued to run our trial of an after school club. At Christmas, the numbers attending will again be reviewed and the future of this facility will be reviewed to see if this is financially sustainable. Should you wish to access this facility, for Reception to Year 6 children only, this can be prebooked and paid for via the ParentMail App.
