Our topic for this half term will be:

MARVELLOUS MATERIALS



Communication/Language

The children will share their experiences of Bonfire Night. As part of our topic, we will talk about our homes and what they are made from. We will continue to develop their language by introducing new vocabulary linked to our stories and topic, such as; house, building, brick, soft and hard. We will also sing lots of songs and rhymes.

Mathematics

In Number we will continue to sort objects by colour, shape and size. We will also focus on: counting aloud in 1's in different contexts and explore pattern. The children will be introduced to body learn its, e.g I have 1 head, 2 hands, 5 fingers on one hand.

Understanding the World

We will learn the names of basic body parts, such as: leg, shoulders, knees, fingers. We will talk about who is in our family. We will explore and talk about different materials and know that people live in houses.

Lunchtime payments

If your child attends the beginning or end of the week sessions and you would like your child to stay for lunch on these days, you are required to pay £2 per day to cover the cost of supervision. This amount needs to be paid on the first day your child attends each week, either on a Monday morning or a Wednesday afternoon.

Our Jigsaw theme is 'Celebrating Difference'. We will learn about how we are the same/ different to others and how we can respect others differences. We will also work on being aware of others needs and including other children in our play.

Physical development

The children will continue to develop their fine and gross motor skills through a variety of fun activities and opportunities, including parachute games, obstacle courses, running games, dancing, threading and weaving.

We will also continue to encourage children to put on their own shoes and coats independently.

Literacy

Our focus stories for this half term will be 'We've All Got Bellybuttons' by David Martin and 'The Three Little Pigs'. We will also read lots of other stories linked to our topic. As we approach the end of term we will share 'The First Christmas' story. We will continue to work on giving meanings to the marks we make when painting and drawing. In phonics we will work on the aspect 'instrumental sounds'.

Expressive Arts

We will continue to explore paints to create different effects, such as colour mixing and printing. We will use construction toys to build houses for the Three Little Pigs. We will also learn a simple Diwali dance. Our role play area will encourage the children to act out Christmas traditions at home.
