In Science the children will be learning about 'Materials.' This project teaches the children about the uses of everyday materials and how materials' properties make them suitable or unsuitable for specific purposes. We will explore how materials can be changed and find out that shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

R.E.

In R.E the children will be focusing on 'Who is Jewish and how do they live?' The children will recognise the words in the Jewish Shema and retell the Jewish story linked to the celebration of Hanukkah. The children will learn about Jewish festivals and understand how people celebrate these special celebrations.

Children should then be able to reflect on their learning of Judaism and discuss what they think is good about thanking, praising and remembering for Jewish people.

Music

In music children will be exploring the piece of music called 'I want to play in a band.' They will explore the pulse and rhythm of this song.

Computing

In computing we will be focusing on programming skills and robot algorithms. The children will develop their understanding of instructions in sequences and predict the outcomes. They will investigate different orders of commands and explain how the order affects the outcome.

Art/DT

In Art the children will learn about portraiture. The children will develop their skills as artists to analyse the portraits of Tudor monarchs. In Design and Technology the children will learn about making and strengthening structures, including different ways of joining materials to make their own beach hut.

Home Reading

Home reading books will be sent home to support our Read Write Inc Phonics and reading programme, as well as books to encourage children to share stories with you and read for pleasure.

Please discuss these with your child and sign their reading record daily and return them to school each day. Each child will be entered into a reading challenge where they must read at least 3 times each week.

PSHE

In PSHE (Jigsaw) we will be working on 'Dreams and Goals.' This will cover choosing goals and thinking about ways that they can achieve them. The children will focus on persevering, even when tasks are hard, and working well in a group to solve problems.

PE

In PE the children will be focusing on developing their Cognitive skills. PE lessons will usually be on a Wednesday.

PE kits should be brought into school every Monday and taken home to be washed every Friday. Children will need their PE kit of plain red shorts and plain white T Shirt, as well as their outdoor kit of plain black joggers and black jumper. Trainers are also required on this day.
