THE PURPOSE OF THIS NEWSLETTER IS TO INFORM YOU OF THE TOPICS THAT YOUR CHILDREN WILL BE STUDYING THIS HALF TERM...



Literacy

This half term, Year 4's literacy sessions will focus around the fiction book 'Frindleswyde' by Natalie and Lauren O'Hara. We will be looking in great detail at the language and description the author has used and incorporating these features into our own narrative writing.

Our main areas of writing will be:

- Recounts
- Letter writing

During our reading lessons, we will be looking at the non-fiction book, 'Viking Voyagers' by Jack Tite to support our learning in history.

Numeracy

Our main areas of study for this half term will be:-

- Learning multiples of the x6, x9 and x7 times tables.
- Dividing using the short division method
- Written multiplication methods

Your child will continue developing their knowledge of the times tables. I would appreciate it if you could support their learning by practising their times tables at home. Our main focus this half term will be 6, 9 and 7 times table.

Science

In Science we will be focusing on the unit 'States of Matter'. We will deepen our knowledge about the three states of matter, solid, liquid and gas and how particles differ between them. Children will be applying their skills to practical and interesting experiments to help develop their learning within Science.

RE/PSHE

In R.E. we will be focusing on the question, 'What kind of world did Jesus want?' In our PSHE lessons, we will be learning all about 'Our Dreams and Goals' where we will discuss our hopes for the future and how to achieve them.

Music

In Music we will continue to learn how to play the violin. In addition, we will also be taking part in a glockenspiel workshop.

Computing

In computing we will begin to learn about the various ways we can use the internet. We will also continue to learn about how to be safe online,

Art/DT

We will be focusing on our Art unit called 'Warp and Weft', while in DT we will be looking at the unit 'Tomb Builders'. Children will be involved in practical activities wherever possible.

History/Geography

This half term will be focusing on our History unit called 'Vikings in Yorkshire' where we will continue to learn about the Viking invasion and the changes they made to our local area. In Geography, our unit will be focused on Rivers and locating them on a map. We will use photos, maps, sources and technology to research and develop our knowledge about the units.

PE

Lessons will take place on a Tuesday afternoon. Children will need their PE kit of plain red shorts and plain white T Shirt. Outdoor kits of plain black joggers and sweatshirt, as well as trainers are also required on this day, as wherever possible, PE lessons will take place outside.

Home Reading

Children will be given their reading books to take home on a daily basis. They should be encouraged to read a few pages or a chapter every night. Please discuss with your child what they have read before signing their reading record. Books should be brought to school every day but must be returned on a Friday so we can change their books.

All children are entered into the class reading challenge where they need to read at least 5 times a week.

Homework/Spellings

Homework will be set on Mondays. Children will have a week to return their completed homework.
