Literacy

This half term, we will be focusing on the two different texts: 'The Tempest' by William Shakespeare and 'Homer's Odyssey'.

Your child will also be focusing on developing their skills with sentence structure, grammar, spellings

Art/DT

This term we will looking at Tints, tones and shades. This project teaches children about colour theory by studying the colour wheel and exploring mixing tints, shades and tones. They learn about significant landscape artworks and features of landscapes before using this knowledge to create landscape paintings. Also, in D.T we will continue looking at where our food comes from and researching benefits of seasonal eating,

Science

In Science our lessons we will be investigating Forces. This project teaches children about the forces of gravity, air resistance, water resistance and friction, with children exploring their effects.

Music

During music lessons the children will learn how to play the Glockenspiel and use their instrument to create accompaniments. We will use the music platform Charanga to enhance our performance skills.

PE

Our PE lessons will be on a **Wednesday**. This term we will be focussing on developing dance skills so your child will need their PE Kit of plain red shorts and plain white t-shirt.

Numeracy

Main areas of study:

- Multiplication
- Division
- Problem solving
- Fractions

Also, we will continue to focus on the quick recall of all of the times tables. Please encourage your child to continue to learn these at home too.

Geography

In Geography we will be studying how climates affect physical environments. This project teaches children about climate zones and their interconnection with vegetation belts and biomes found around the world.

History

In History we are looking at how Britain was effected by the Second World War, in particular how the home front helped the war effort.

RE

During RE we will be looking at what it means to be a Muslim and live in Britain today.

Homework

Home work will be set each Friday on spag.com and on TTrockstars. This needs to be completed by the following Thursday.

Reading / Home Reading

Our reading text is called 'Iliad' by Homer Each week we will read a new chapter and complete comprehension questions.

Children will be given their home reading books to take home daily. They should be encouraged to read a few pages every night. Please discuss with your child what they have read before signing their reading record. Reading records need to be brought into school each day, so your child can progress on the class challenge of reading **5 times each week.**
